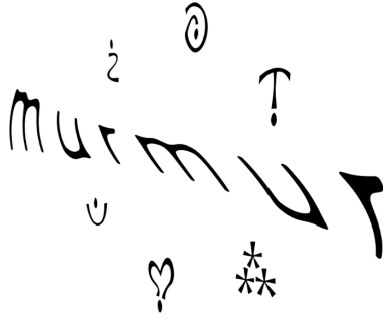

Murmur is a 300-person gathering, nestled between a lake, forest, and mountain in the Laurentians. Each ticket includes three days/nights of programming, access to hiking trails, paddle boats, swimming, and the sauna. The site has room for all of us to gather comfortably, AND no nearby neighbours. :)

This document will walk you through the accommodation options available at murmur: Indoor & Camping.

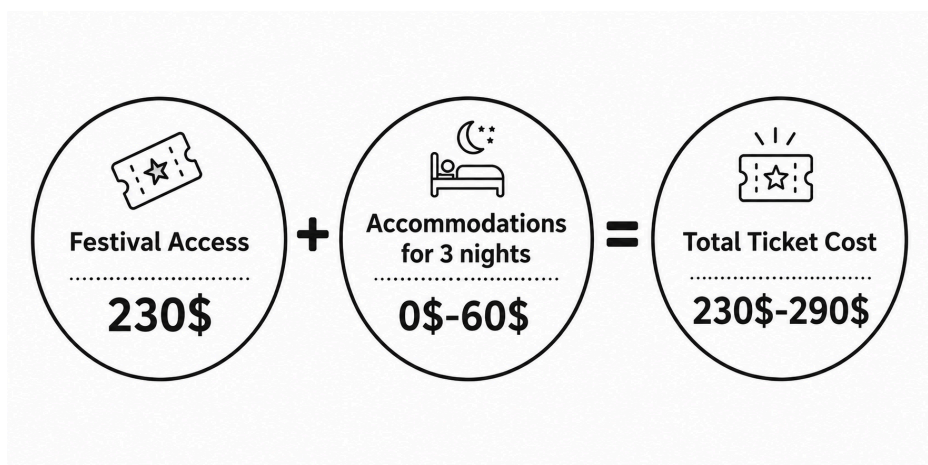
All indoor accommodations are heated and offer a great balance of rustic & luxury.

If you're planning to camp, please come prepared with appropriate gear and warm layers.

Group cabins must be purchased as a full unit per capacity.



PRICING OVERVIEW



Coming as a group? Tickets will be priced as a unit.

Accommodation Type	Capacity	Total Ticket Cost
Forest Gîte*	Up to 4 people	\$290/person + tax
Beach Chalet*	Up to 5 people	\$280/person + tax
Entire Dorm Room (Auberge)	Up to 4 or 5 people	\$250/person + tax
Camping	Varies by tent size	\$230/person + tax

Please note that **chalets and **gites** are only being sold as entire units (i.e., as a bundle of 4 or 5 tickets) at this time. Coordinate with your friends and purchase as a group! These are the nicest accommodations and they're well worth organizing yourselves for.*

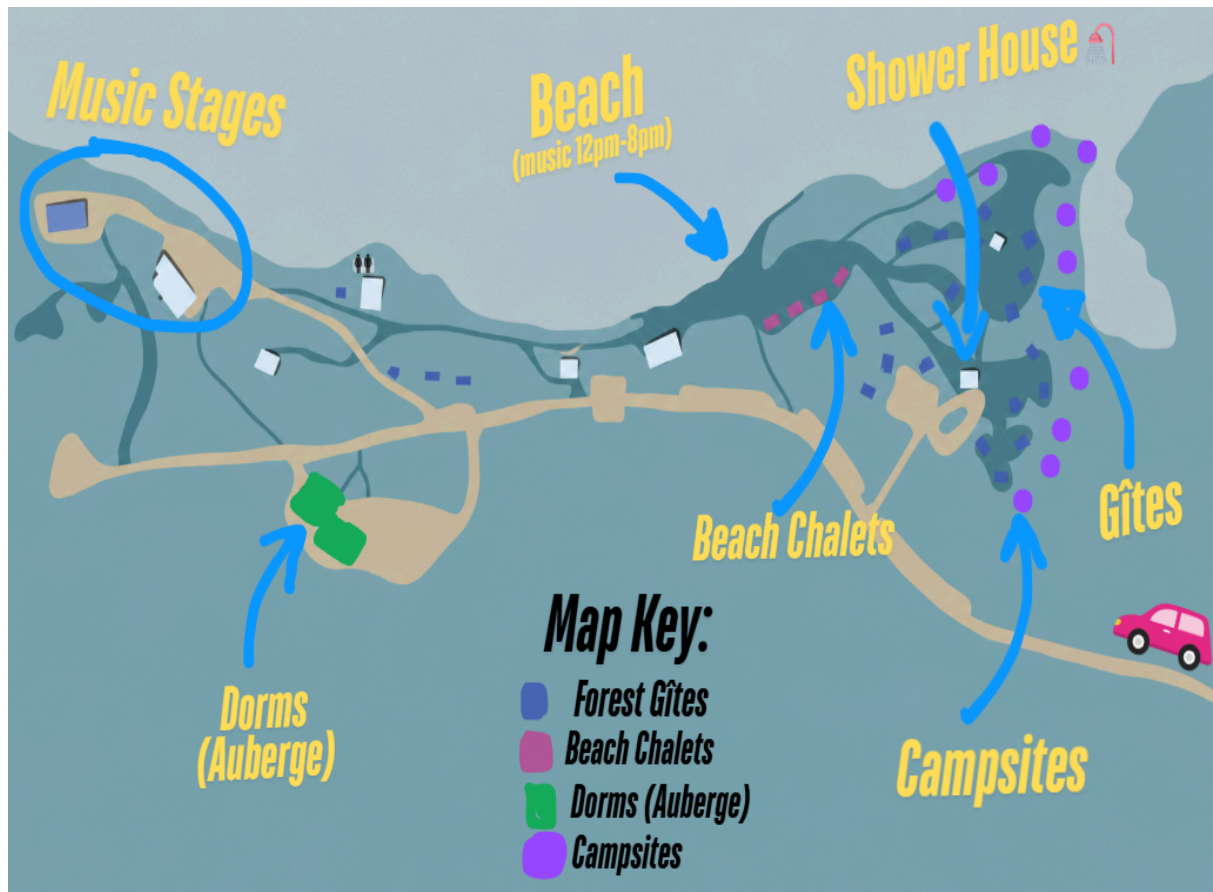
Riding solo?

Accommodation Type	Total Ticket Cost
Single Bed in Mixed Dorm (Auberge)	\$250 + tax
Camping	\$230 + tax

Murmur is DIY at its core. We have no corporate sponsors or grant funding, and our ticket prices reflect the lowest price we can sustainably offer.



MURMUR SITE MAP



1. Forest Gîte

For groups of 4 (two beds are shared)



Private, modern, open-concept cabins in the forest. Each gîte includes:

- 1 queen bed + 1 double futon (i.e. each bed must be shared by 2 guests)
- Private bathroom (toilet + shower)
- Private kitchenette with:
 - mini fridge
 - hot plates
 - coffee maker
 - toaster oven
 - dishes and basic cookware

Ideal if you're coming with close friends and want your own comfortable, self-contained space. Gîtes are located farthest from music and activities.



2. Beach Chalet

For groups of 5 (one double bed is shared)



These are located on the water/volleyball court. Each chalet includes:

- 1 double bed + 3 single beds (i.e., 1 bed must be shared by 2 guests)
- Private kitchenette with:
 - fridge/freezer
 - hot plates
 - coffee maker
 - toaster oven
 - dishes and basic cookware
- Private bathroom with toilet (no shower included)
- Access to shared shower facilities nearby

A slightly more spacious option — best suited for groups who want to stay close to the lake, where there will be music and activities in the daytime from around 12pm-8pm.



3. Entire Dorm Room (Auberge) *For groups of 4 or 5*



Located in the main lodge. Rooms include:

- 4 single bunk beds OR 3 single bunk beds + 1 double bed
- Shared bathrooms/showers on each floor
- Dorm guests do not have access to any kitchen
- Designated area outside of the auberge for cooking (must bring your own cooler & camping stove)

Best for groups who want a more affordable option.



4. Single Bed in Mixed Dorm (Auberge)



Randomly assigned in a dorm room. Co-ed and FLINTA options available.
Includes:

- Single bunk bed in a 4-person dorm room
 - Shared bathrooms/showers on each floor
 - Dorm guests do not have access to any kitchen
 - Designated area outside of the auberge for cooking (must bring your own cooler & camping stove)

5. Camping



Campers are free to camp around the location as long as they are not intruding on the privacy of others and are aware of their proximity to stages. Arrive early and you can score a lovely lakeside campsite with a picnic bench :)

PRACTICAL INFORMATION

Accessibility

All accommodations require at least 1–2 steps to access. The campground is relatively flat, and the road connecting the cabins, auberge, and stages (see map above) is wide, flat, and well maintained. Car access on this road is not permitted.

The auberge is situated on a small hill and requires a short uphill walk from the main path of the festival.

If you have any questions regarding accessibility or would like to discuss your specific needs before purchasing a ticket, please contact us using the email listed at the bottom of this page.

Arrival & Departure

You must arrive at the site by car. Roads are well maintained, so any car will likely make it without difficulty.

Parking is \$20 per vehicle with 2 people or less in it - we encourage carpooling!

Check-in hours are Friday 4pm-9pm, and Saturday 12pm-3pm. Re-entry is permitted between those hours. The gate will be closed outside of these hours.

Check-out is 10am Monday. We strongly encourage people to stay the final night and discourage any attendees from traveling before resting.

Kitchen Access

- Gîtes & Beach Chalets include a private kitchenette.
- Dorm guests (auberge) do not have access to a kitchen, but may use a cooler and camping stove outdoors in designated areas.
- Campsite guests should plan accordingly and bring any cooking equipment they may require.



FAQ

Can I book a gîte or chalet with fewer people than the listed capacity?

Yes — but they are priced per unit.

If you'd like to book one with fewer people than listed, send an email (listed below) and we can work a custom booking option.

Can I request a roommate in the mixed dorms (auberge)?

Yes — if you choose to buy a single bed in a mixed dorm, there will be an option to request one (1) roommate on the ticketing page, but it is **not guaranteed**, as managing roommate requests for almost 300 people can get very complicated.

If you want the full guarantee of staying with your friends, please organize yourselves and book an entire room!

If you choose to go solo but would like to stay in a FLINTA-only dorm, there will also be an option to request this option on the ticketing page.

Do dorms in the auberge have kitchen access?

No — dorm guests in the auberge do not have access to any kitchen. You may bring a cooler and camping stove to cook on the picnic tables outside in front of the auberge.

Is there food available for sale?

Yes! Delicious food and beverages (alcoholic + non-alcoholic) will be available on site for sale. A schedule outlining when/where food is sold will be announced closer to the event.

You are welcome to bring a cooler + small camping stove to cook on the picnic tables outside. No open flame BBQ.

Are there showers?

Yes! Showers are available for everyone.

- Gîtes: private shower inside each unit
- Chalets: no shower inside (shared facilities nearby the Gîtes area)
- Dorms: shared bathrooms and showers on each floor



- Camping: shared shower facilities

Do I need to bring bedding?

Yes — all attendees must bring their own bedding, mattresses are included (e.g., sleeping bag and sheets), pillow, and towels.

Can I come alone?

Yes, we encourage it!

Dorm tickets (single bed) are the easiest option for solo attendees. You'll be placed in a mixed room, and it's a great way to meet people. A FLINTA-only dorm option is available.

Are there single-day tickets?

No — this is a full weekend gathering. All tickets include accommodation and festival access for 3 entire nights. Checkout is Monday at 10am.

Are tickets refundable?

No — all ticket sales are final. Please email us if you have arranged to sell your ticket to someone and we will change the name on the ticket. If the event sells out we can connect you with someone on the wait list.

Are there discount tickets?

We have a **small** number of tickets for those facing financial insecurity in our community (prioritizing QTBIPOC+). Send an Email to contact@murmur.diy with 'REDUCED TICKET' in the subject line - we will send you the application form. Applications close July 22 and applicants will be notified shortly after with a decision.

What items are prohibited on site?

- Drugs
- BYOB Alcohol (bar on site)
- Personal campfires
- Fireworks
- Generators
- Weapons of any kind
- Glass bottles



- Large sound systems or amplified music in campsites
 - Drones
 - Laser pointers
 - Unauthorized vending or commercial activity

A NOTE ON PARTICIPATION

It takes a village, your contribution matters!

Murmur strives to provide adequate staffing for all aspects of production, safety, and harm reduction to ensure you're well taken care of, while also creating space for participants (**you!**) to contribute to the experience.

Participation can be as simple as:

- Picking up trash off the ground
- Offering a ride to someone to and from the site
- Bringing snacks to share with your neighbours
- Offering to host a workshop or skill-share
- Serving tea during a late-night performance

We will be sharing more information with ticket holders on more opportunities to participate, like leading a workshop or applying for 'micro-grant' funding to help bring an installation or creative project to life.
